**Air Pollution Awareness** The Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC)'s Air Quality Awareness Program encourages residents to take action to reduce air pollution. MVRPC partners with the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) on air quality issues. RAPCA is responsible for monitoring and reporting air quality readings in Montgomery, Greene, Miami and Clark Counties. On days when air pollution levels are forecasted to be high, an Air Pollution Advisory (APA) is issued. It's especially important on these days to modify your behavior to reduce air pollution.
