Points to Ponder

There may be problems with their neighbors or an employee may have gotten up late and was stuck in a mile-long traffic jam. Then there is the simple fact that some employees have a general negative attitude, are not happy with their job, or

All of those influence employee safety behavior. These could cause an employee to be injured or injure someone else. (Also, fatigue, anger, frustration, distraction, and the use of drugs and/or alcohol all put an employee at serious

Managers and supervisors need to be aware of these factors and the tell-tale signs that may be observable. I recommend that if there are any employees that appear to exhibit any of these signs that either the manager or

supervisor sit down with that employee to determine the causes and see if there is something that can be done to help

employee take a drug or alcohol test. If you do, don't let the employee drive themselves. Take the employee and bring them back. Then call their family to have someone take them home. Don't let them drive if you suspect they may

Pay attention to the signs that an employee may be at risk and counsel the employee on these when necessary. If counseling isn't feasible or the behavior is such that an employee is likely to be at risk for a serious injury or cause a serious injury to other employees then that employee may not be a suitable candidate for continued employment.

Safety unfortunately is not always an employee's top individual priority. They take their safety for granted or they think accidents happen to other employees. Many times, during the day they may let outside factors influence their decision

eliminate these. Sometimes just listening or talking with an employee may help. Some positive counseling can go a long way in helping employees resolve these behavior problems. Sometimes unfortunately an employee may be in such a state that they are not fit for duty or may be at risk to themselves, other employees, or the general public. In those situations, I recommend that you call a family member to see if they can come and drive the employee home. In some cases, you may even want to offer a cab ride. The employee may refuse this, if so document that you offered this to the employee. If there is a concern that an employee may be under the influence of drugs or alcohol you may want to have that
