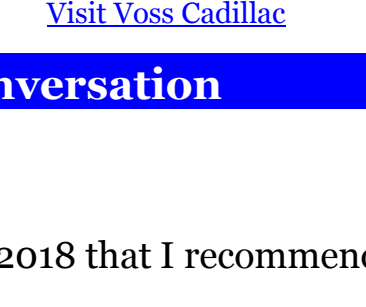

We have a strong speaker schedule in place for 2018 that I recommend you review and plan to attend.

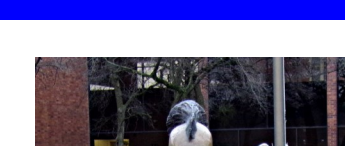

Learn to use our live new websites, Chamber and Safety Council, to select the speaker, topic and date that interest you.

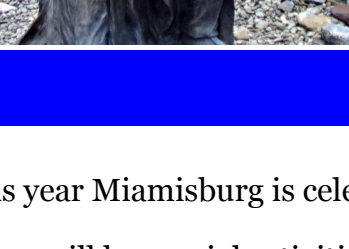
Both of our event locations have limited seating. I recommend calling the office and reserving a seat early.

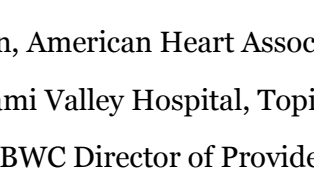

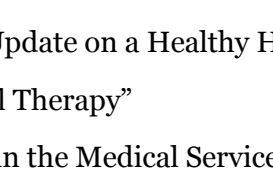

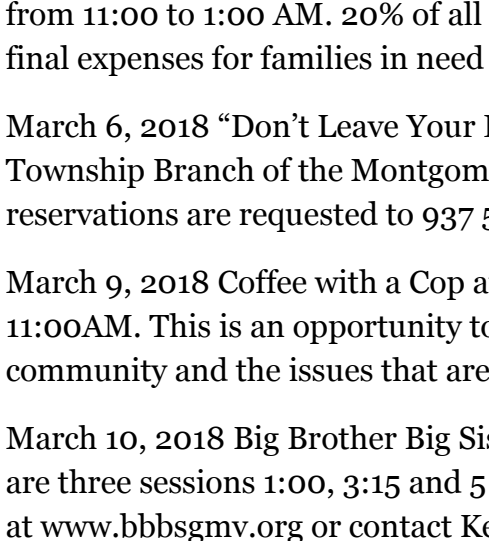
Safety Council Speakers and Information

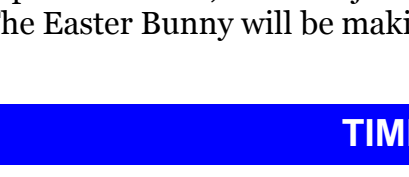

Chamber Night at the Dayton Dragons

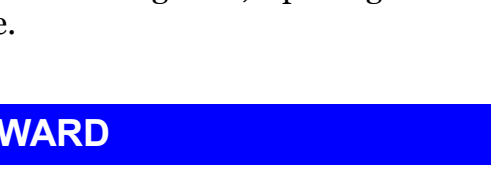


Believe it or not, spring is right around the corner and soon it will be time for the annual Chamber Night at the Dragons. This is always a big event and usually sells out quickly.

On a recent morning I sat down with Marlene Miller, the wife of the late Fred J. Miller and the co-founder of the present day FJM Inc.

Fred was raised in east Dayton, one of seven children, and lived in the shadow of St. Mary's Church. He learned baton so that he could obtain the position of Drum Major at Chaminade High School.

The Blackhawks had several homes in downtown Dayton over the years and it seems like the wrecking ball always followed them. They found a new home on Westpark in Centerville which with one relocation to another building down the street, served them well until they built their current building off Washington Church Rd.

Musical competitions went through a change from baton to precision drill team and finally became the color guard teams that we know today. In the 1991-92 period, the Millers began producing flags and costumes for the guard teams.

One thing led to another and it was suggested by designer, Michael Desario that they begin making the band uniforms as well. To find out information and to seek suppliers, the Millers would travel to New York.

While the competition has changed through the years and there are fewer uniform manufacturers than there once were, FJM Inc. has survived and thrived due to the attention to detail, as well as providing great customer service and a quality product.

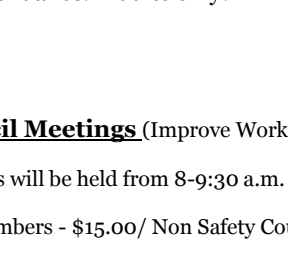
While it is still a little way off, April will be here before we know it.
